

START OF TERM IN SEPTEMBER

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

(Please keep this page handy for reference in September)

PARENTS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO DRIVE VEHICLES ONTO ANY OF THE COLLEGE GROUNDS TO DROP OFF OR PICK UP STUDENTS

<i>Where do I go on my first day in September?</i>	You go straight to Kingston Theatre in the Kingston Building at 8.20a.m. and await instructions from staff. You will then be taken to your Form room.
<i>Where should I meet my parents at the end of the first day in September?</i>	Make sure that, before you are dropped off, you and your parents, or whoever will be meeting you, have agreed where to meet at the end of the day.
<i>Where do I go on my second day in September?</i>	On your second day you should go directly to the Barossa building and when the bells sound, go straight to your Form room.
<i>Where do I get my ID card?</i>	Your ID card will be given to you by your Form Tutor at the beginning of the first day.
<i>Can I still buy food if I don't have money on my ID card</i>	Yes, BUT ONLY FOR THE FIRST WEEK OF TERM , after which you should make sure you have money on your card.
<i>Do I have to bring PE kit on the first day?</i>	No, because you won't know what your timetable will be until you get here.
<i>I have to take regular medication - what do I do with it?</i>	Your parent should hand any medication into reception at the beginning of term, named and with directions for use.
<i>What equipment do I need to bring in on my first day in September</i>	Pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, notebook, packed lunch (if you are not going to buy lunch).
<i>What about my locker key?</i>	If you have ordered and paid for a key, it will be given to you during the first week of term.
<i>Where do I get on the bus to come to College and where do I get off?</i>	Your parents will have arranged, either with the Local Authority or the bus company, where and what time you get your bus to come to College. All the buses, apart from public buses, stop outside Barossa. This is where you get off at the start and on at the end of the day.
<i>How do I know where to get my bus home?</i>	All Lower College students (which includes Year 7) go to the area between the Barossa building and the Sixth Form Centre. Staff on duty will tell you which line to join for your bus. You will then be called to board the bus when it arrives.
