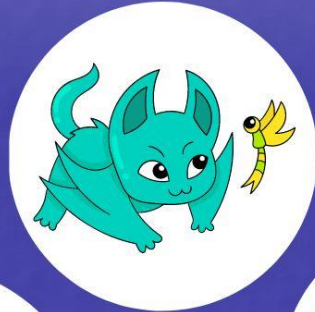

Students in all Year Groups are invited to participate in PiXL Edge under the guidance of Dr Sinclair (in M4). There is no particular set day or time for this as it is student led. **Students work independently and at their own pace, choosing tasks that suit them, and progress from Apprentice to Pioneer to Graduate to Master's level.** PiXL Edge is a framework for secondary schools and sixth form providers to develop and accredit students in attitudes, attributes and skills essential for college and university applications, employability and life.

Through a series of accredited tasks and activities (including target-setting and self-reflection) PiXL Edge enables students to systematically enhance their skills of Leadership, Organisation, Resilience, Initiative and Communication.
