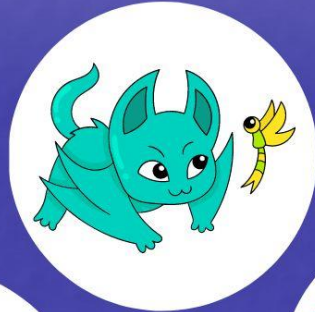

PiXL Edge is a framework for secondary schools and sixth form providers to develop and accredit students in attitudes, attributes and skills essential for college and university applications, employability and life.

Through a series of accredited tasks and activities (including target-setting and self-reflection) PiXL Edge enables students to systematically enhance their skills of Leadership, Organisation, Resilience, Initiative and Communication.

There is also a new accreditation: Green Edge, which provides a framework designed to develop and accredit environmentally conscious students.
