The 9th Annual Parents' Survey was completed by 144 parents and carers in 2016. We are delighted that the overall results show 13 questions with satisfaction rates of over 90% from a total of 16 questions. This survey provides us with lots of detailed feedback which is very valuable.

For the third year running we were particularly pleased to have the endorsement of 98% of parents who believe that the College is well led and managed and would recommend Collingwood to other parents. However, we are disappointed to note the responses to the setting and marking of home learning which remains an area of concern for too many parents. This will be a key area for addressing in our next improvement plan.

Finally, we would like to thank all those parents who have taken the time to complete the survey and to tell us where we are doing well and how you think we could do better.

Actions as a result of your feedback

Behaviour

- Pro-active targeting of amber and red ATL cohort by Pastoral staff post reports
- Behaviour specialist to work on restorative behaviour management with a small group of KS3 boys
- Re-examine the classroom plan and the 8 steps to effective learning

Parents' Evenings and ARDs

- Review the structure of ARDs
- Departments to establish a protocol for providing joint feedback for split groups, in particular Science
- Review the rooming arrangements
- Ask staff to display appointment order and timetables outside their classrooms

Home learning

- Re-iterate expectations of home learning in staff meetings and through training programmes
- Ensure teachers follow the home learning policy via the book scrutiny process
- Senior staff to monitor the marking of home learning

Communication

- Respond to parental communications within 3 days, wherever possible
- Senior Staff to be copied into parental communications

Progress

- Ensure that information about the new GCSE 1-9 grading is communicated effectively
- An assessment flight path linking KS3 STEPs to the new KS4 GCSE will be launched to all stakeholders to monitor progress
- To provide updated assessment information via the Co-Principals' newsletters
