Introduction to booklet

The 10th Annual Parents' Survey was completed by 128 parents and carers in 2018. We are delighted that the overall results show 13 questions with satisfaction rates of over 85% from a total of 17 questions. This survey provides us with lots of detailed feedback which is very valuable.

We were particularly pleased to have the endorsement of 93% of parents who believe that the College is well led and managed and would recommend Collingwood to other parents. Further, we are delighted with the 18% increase for marking home learning although the setting of appropriate home learning still remains a key focus for us.

Where there are common issues raised and for those questions which received the poorest satisfaction rates we have provided feedback on what actions we are taking to address your concerns.

Finally, we would like to thank all those parents who have taken the time to complete the survey and to tell us where we are doing well and how you think we could do better.

Actions as a result of your feedback
