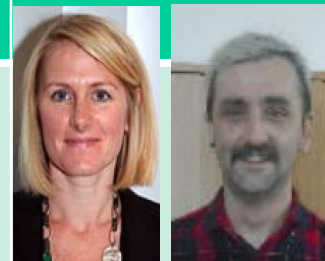

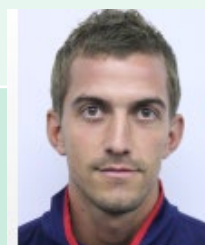

English Baccalaureate subjects

EBacc subjects are the core academic subjects and are regularly asked for by college and university courses – worth bearing in mind when your child is deciding which GCSEs to take. Students don't need to have studied all of these to go to university, but having their GCSE mix steered towards EBacc subjects will help keep their options open for further study and future careers.

EBacc subjects consist of the following choices:

- GCSE English Language and Literature
- GCSE Maths
- GCSE Triple Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- GCSE Combined Science
- GCSE Computer Science
- GCSE Languages – French, Spanish, Italian
- GCSE History
- GCSE Geography



Choices

- At this time in year 8, students chose :
 - a 1 year option (to end summer 2020)
 - a 3 year Free Choice Option
 - a 3 year EBacc Option
 - Now in year 9, students will choose another two Options for years 10 and 11
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Year 9 Experience to date


- All year 9 students should be making good progress in their core subjects, their open option and EBacc option
- Everyone should complete an external qualification in June/July - Music, Business, Computing , Citizenship, Project, Drama (LAMDA) , Art, Sport
- In year 10 everyone will complete GCSE RS (Short Course) - may choose to top up to Full Course in year 11

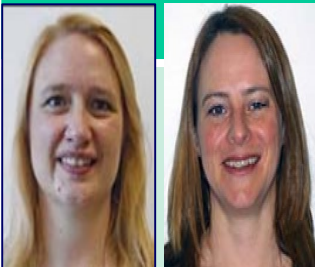
Completed option forms must be handed in **by FRIDAY 28 FEBRUARY** to Barossa Reception

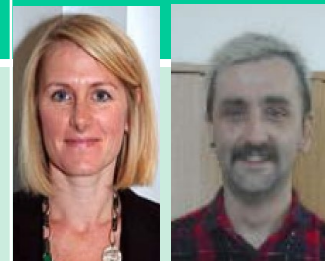
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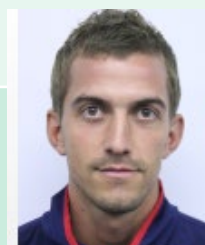
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
